







Why Digital Health Incentive Scheme ?





Eligibility Criteria





Health Facilities having 10 or more beds as provided in the Health Facility Registry



Laboratory/radiology diagnostics centers or by whatever name called



Entities providing ABDM enabled digital solutions (Digital Solution Companies)

Benefits will be provided to the health facilities only for transactions done by them above the base level of transactions (i.e. only the transactions above the threshold).

Salient features of the Incentive Policy



Healthcare Facility	Base Level Criteria	Incentives	Cost Incentives for Dia (HMIS and LMIS) Co	
Hospitals with more than 10 beds	50 Transactions per bed per month	Rs 20 per additional transaction above the base level	For incentives claimed by hospitals/labs under DHIS using their software	25% of the corresponding incentive amount received by the eligible facilities
Diagnostic facilities/ Labs	500 Transactions per month	Rs 15 per additional transaction above the base level	 For other Transactions by small clinics, nursing homes, health lockers, Teleconsultation platforms, small clinics etc.* (*Provided the transactions are more than 200 per month) 	Rs 5 per Transaction

Salient features of the Incentive Policy



- Digital Solution Companies (DSCs) will be provided an incentive of 25% of the incentive amount received by the eligible health facilities using their digital solutions.
- For ABHA linked transactions done by facilities not eligible for direct incentives (Clinics/small hospitals/ health lockers/Teleconsultation platforms etc.), an incentive would be provided to Digital Solution Companies. It is expected that the benefits provided to the DSCs will help reduce the cost or will be further transferred to the concerned health facilities to cover their cost of digitization etc.
- DSCs which complete NABH/QCI or any other similar certification specified by NHA from time to time shall be eligible for 20% extra incentives including maximum incentive cap. Only facilities using NABH certified version of concerned HMIS will be provided this additional benefit.

Capping the Incentives





Maximum incentive available under the scheme to any health facility or DSC shall be restricted to Rs 4 crore during the course of the current policy.

Transactions done by virtual facilities created in HFR will not be considered for the calculation of incentives under this policy.



NHA shall set up a mechanism to capture different types of transactions (stakeholder wise) and report the same on a publicly available benefits dashboard.
